

## SDM-IMD students win prizes in BRICS meet at Shanghai



Mysore, Nov.10- Shanghai University's International School of Business and Economics, Shanghai, China, had organised 5th ABBS (Association of the BRICS Business Schools) students meet, ABBS Biennial Conference and Board Meeting from Oct. 24 to 28.
