Students extend support to special school

MYSURU: The students of Shri Dharmasthala Manjunatheshwara Institute for Management Development (SDMIMD) extended monetary support to Nireekshe (day care and activity centre for special children) and Mysore District Parents Association for Empowering Developmentally Disabled (MDPAEDD).
