

Don't be desperate, students told

Subroto Bagchi addresses students graduating from SDMIMD

MYSORE: Mindtree Ltd. chairman Subroto Bagchi on Friday said students were responsible for creating institutions to ensure the country's success, not just to build their career.

He was speaking at the 19th annual convocation of the Sri Dharmasthala Manjunatheshwara Institute for Management Development (SDMIMD). Mr. Bagchi said the country's success depended on the quality of institutions it produced. Therefore, students should also look at building institutions, he said.
