

SDM-IMD hosts workshop on preventing plagiarism



Mysore, July 11 (KMC)- A two-day workshop on avoiding plagiarism was held at SDM Institute for Management Development.

During the inaugural session, Dr. R. Jagadeesh, Professor-Operations, SDM IMD stressed on the need for adequate quality standards.

Dr. M.V. Sunil, Co-ordinator of the workshop, opined that an effective strategy to introduce this

prevention layer is within the reach of academic community, with the available free or open source software.

Dr. C.P. Ramasesh, Librarian, University of Mysore, delivered the talk on 'Plagiarism – an overview' and Anand Byrappa, Global Leader, Whitney Knowledge Centre, GE, Bangalore spoke on the topic 'IPR – Copyright, Digital Right Manage-

ment, Creative Commons and Plagiarism.'

Participants from Engineering, Medical, Dental, Ayurveda, Management and Library Science domain had a hands-on training on anti-plagiarism software Turnitin, iThenticate and the open source software – Viper. The resource persons demonstrated how PhD thesis, dissertations and journal

articles, could be checked for academic integrity and use of available tools to improve the quality of publication.

Dr. H. Gayathri, Deputy Director inaugurated the workshop and Prof. Nilanjan Sengupta, Chairman, SDM Research Centre for Management Studies, SDM IMD delivered the valedictory address and distributed the certificates to the participants.
