● Dr N S Harinarayana spoke about the requirement of Quality in research

Agrahara: "Quality research in India has become a scarce commodity. Quantitative measures are applied to measure the research output of institutions. Indian institutions have not listed in top ranking institutes in the world. Enhancing the research facility to match the world standards and adopting the systematic approach for conducting the research projects will help India to mark its presence

in the world research map" said Dr N S Harinarayana, Associate Professor of UoM.

Speaking at the Literature Review workshop held at SDM Institute for Management Development, Mysore on Dec 19 and 20, he said, providing access to electronic journals, e-books and other open access resources will help to increase the quality in research. There has to be

regular training programmes from the scientist community to promote its use.

Library adviser Dr I R N Goudar, Coordinator of the Workshop Dr Sunil M V, Dr D S Guru from University of Mysore, Professor of Operations at SDMIMD Dr R Jagadeesh and Professor of Marketing Department at SDMIMD Dr M R Suresh served as
