Mysore, Oct. 19 (MTY&RNN)- Prof. Y. Bhagwan Memorial Inter-Collegiate Debate contest, organised by Rotary Mysore Midtown and SDM-IMD, was inaugurated by Advocate L. Govindraju of Bangalore at SDM-IMD premises on Chamundi Hill Road here

this morning.

Speaking on the occasion, he said that Prof. Bhagwan was a teacher of highest standards besides being a great orator who had abundant knowledge of all subjects and used to draw students of even other classes during his lecture.

More than 60 students from various colleges in city took part in the debates on topics like 'Truth Vs Truth', 'Idea Vs Idea' and 'Right Vs Right'.

Govindraju said today's debate would throw light on the embedded talent among those taking part in the debate which

will enhance the knowledge of others present.

The winner of the debate will get a cash prize of Rs. 20,000 while the runner-up will get Rs. 15,000 and the third prize winner will carry home Rs. 10,000 apart from seven consolation prizes which are up for grabs.
